This outline has been constructed to help preachers and teachers pass this teaching to others. - 2.2.3 Other pictures
 - Run the race
 - Building
 - Journey
 - Marriage

2.3 The first phase of salvation is about what God has DONE

- 2.3.1 Provides ASSURANCE
- 2.3.2 Stages 2 and 3 build on the first leading to service and inheritance
- 2.2.3 We do not run the race to qualify for salvation; we run to win the PRIZE

3. Isaiah 27:1 Evil defeated

- 3.1 Our position is settled
- 3.2 Illustration the Kenyan lady's daughter gets a visa with official permission to stay!

3.3 In that day... looking forward...

3.3.1 Imagery from a Canaanite myth to illustrate the total defeat and overthrow of evil

3.3.2 Jesus has done this.

- Christians have been transferred into God's kingdom, (Col 1:13)
- Out of Adam and in Christ (Romans 5-6)
- Out of darkness and into light (Eph. 8:5-14).
- 3.4 This cannot be reversed or taken away.

4. Isaiah 27:2 A pleasant vineyard

- 4.1 A picture of being cared for watered
- 4.2 Protected
- 4.3 Provided for
- 4.4 In a position to bear fruit

5. Isaiah 27:3 I am not angry

- 5.1 God has no anger against us
- 5.2 But Grace should not be abused or taken for granted
- 5.3 There is discipline God may not be pleased with everything we do
- 5.4 But the basic position is that he is NOT ANGRY WITH US
- 5.5 He will DEFEND his people

6. Isaiah 27:13 Those in Egypt and Assyria will worship at Jerusalem

- 6.1 In the days to come the gospel will reach the whole world
- 6.2 God has a world vision
- 6.3 In this we can all play a part
